- WHEREAS,*** *these were the earliest Chinese engineers exposed to modern technologies and were responsible for most of the early technology transfers between the United States and China; and*
- WHEREAS,*** *in 1977 the Institute was renamed the “Chinese Institute of Engineers, USA” (CIE/USA), with a mission to serve members throughout the United States, and to date the CIE/USA has six chapters; and*
- WHEREAS,*** *the Dallas-Fort Worth Area Chapter (CIE/USA-DFW) was established in 1989 and has maintained close ties with major corporations and government bodies around the world; and*
- WHEREAS,*** *local members cover many professional areas including microelectronics, information technologies, telecommunications, biotechnology and business management; and*
- WHEREAS,*** *CIE/USA promotes joint interest and partnerships in technology in the United States, China and Taiwan.*
