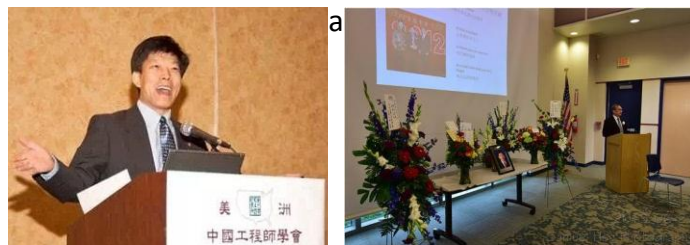
English Speech Contest
